DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Dilute spray application is best. Calculate spray volume so that actual water rate is just to run-off. Avoid spraying under fast or slow drying conditions.

WARNING: Gro-Calcium is not a buffered solution and does not contain a wetting agent. Phytotoxicity is possible on sensitive crops and under adverse application conditions.

Gro-Calcium is only certified for organic use on apples.

Gro-Calcium may be applied with most herbicides, insecticides, fungicides or nutrient sprays. It is

compatible with most chemicals, but for unknown or doubtful chemicals a test mix should be made up. Generally, Gro-Calcium should be added before most chemicals, except where a product data sheet specifies otherwise i.e. cupric hydroxide.

Always apply diluted or mixed chemicals immediately, do not store.

Gro-Calcium should be applied in low light conditions in the morning or evening or on cloudy days. Do not apply during periods of high sunlight, during rain or prior to expected rain.
