DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For brush application to pruning wounds and grafting sealant on grapes, ornamental trees and pip and summer fruit to reduce the incidence and extent of fungal invasion. For control of European Canker in pipfruit, Silver Leaf in pip and summerfruit, Eutypa lata, Botryosphaeria Dieback and Petri Disease on grapes.

- 1. Shake thoroughly before use.
- 2. Never thin with water as product will not work.
- 3. Apply thickly to dry wound surface or graft union with paint brush or applicator back on the same day the pruning cut or graft is made.
- 4. DO NOT apply to grafting wound before taping or if union is not perfect, or the BARRIER may penetrate the union and prevent the graft from taking.
- 5. DO NOT apply to wounds or cuts showing extensive brown staining. 6. Apply only to plant wounds during the dormant period.
- 7. DO NOT use on grapevines during the growing season (start of flowering to end of harvest).
- 8. Apply on fine, sunny, windy days not on wet, foggy days as product will not dry.
- 9. Large wounds (> 50mm diameter) on a main trunk would benefit from a second application.
- 10. Brushes should be washed out in water after use. 11. Reseal container after use to prevent skin formation.
